Overdue notices will be given for books that have not been returned. Students will not be fined for late books. However, there will be charges for damaged or lost books. The price to replace a book is indicated on the overdue notice.

Edgebrook students will be learning and/or reviewing how important it is to take care of the books that are checked out from the library. Gentle reminders and support from home would be greatly appreciated! Here are the rules that I teach the students and expect all of them to follow:

1. Handle books with clean hands
2. Never mark or write in books
3. Be careful turning pages so they won't tear
4. Keep your library books away from food and drink
5. Keep your books clean and dry
6. Carry your books in your book bag
7. Keep library books in a safe place at home
8. Return your library books on time so others can read them
