Close Reading and Students with Attention Deficit Disorder

Annotating text can be **amazing** for students who have problems focusing and paying attention. Annotating keeps students focused, because it requires them to stay actively involved with the text. Annotating makes it difficult for students to drift off. It also enables the teacher to monitor attentional issues and reading progress, simply by checking on the annotations.

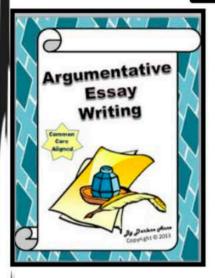

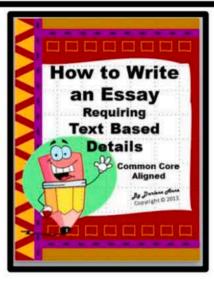

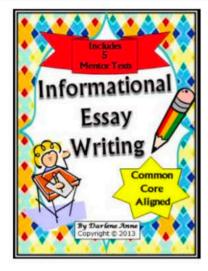
