Navigating the Menus


Use the icons at the top of the Lightbox Menu to quickly access standard features and supplementary resources.

Hovering over or clicking an icon, such as Video, brightens the pages containing that feature. Pages that don't have any video fade out. Click the page you want to go to that has the feature you want to see.
