Superintendent's Report

Dr. Hoffman shared that on October 30 BPAC hosted Spanish speaking families attending a Dia de Los Muertos event at Edgebrook School. Spanish author Margarita del Mazo joined the event. Additionally, on November 13 these families were welcomed to the McHenry Public Library to learn about all the resources available. The Tri-Conference will be held this weekend

in Chicago. There will be no school on November 25 and 26 due to Parent/Teacher Conference, and no school on November 27,28,29 in honor of Thanksgiving. The Foundation's Annual Craft/Vendor Fair will be held on December 7 at Parkland School. Our next Board Meeting will be held on December 17 at Central. Dr. Hoffman shared the results of the district's Health Screening—358 staff members participated in the screening and 317 received the flu shot. These are our highest numbers to date. He also reported that over 90% of staff are satisfied with their job—so not only do we have healthier staff, but also a happier staff. In closing Dr. Hoffman congratulated Board President Matt Stauner and Vice President Mark Jaeger on achieving Level 1 Board Member Status.

Freedom of Information Act Requests

Dr. Hoffman reported on three FOIA Requests and the responses to those requests. Board Member Sivertsen asked how many the district receives annually; approximately 10 per year.

Instructional Program—Landmark School

Dr. Laudadio introduced Landmark Principal Margaret Carey. Mrs. Carey presented a video that Landmark staff members put together on "See Saw" which is a digital resource for staff, students and parents. Mr. Stauner thanked Mrs. Carey for a very informative presentation.
