

Subtractive bilingualism

occurs when an individual's first language and culture are replaced by the new language and culture. Negative self-concept developed.

Additive bilingualism

occurs when a second language and culture have been acquired without loss or displacement or an individual's first language and culture. Positive self-concept developed.
