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What is Symbaloo?

Symbaloo is a social bookmarking tool that lets you collect and organize websites into **webmixes**. Webmixes show each website you collect as a **tile**.



Webmix: Collection of related websites

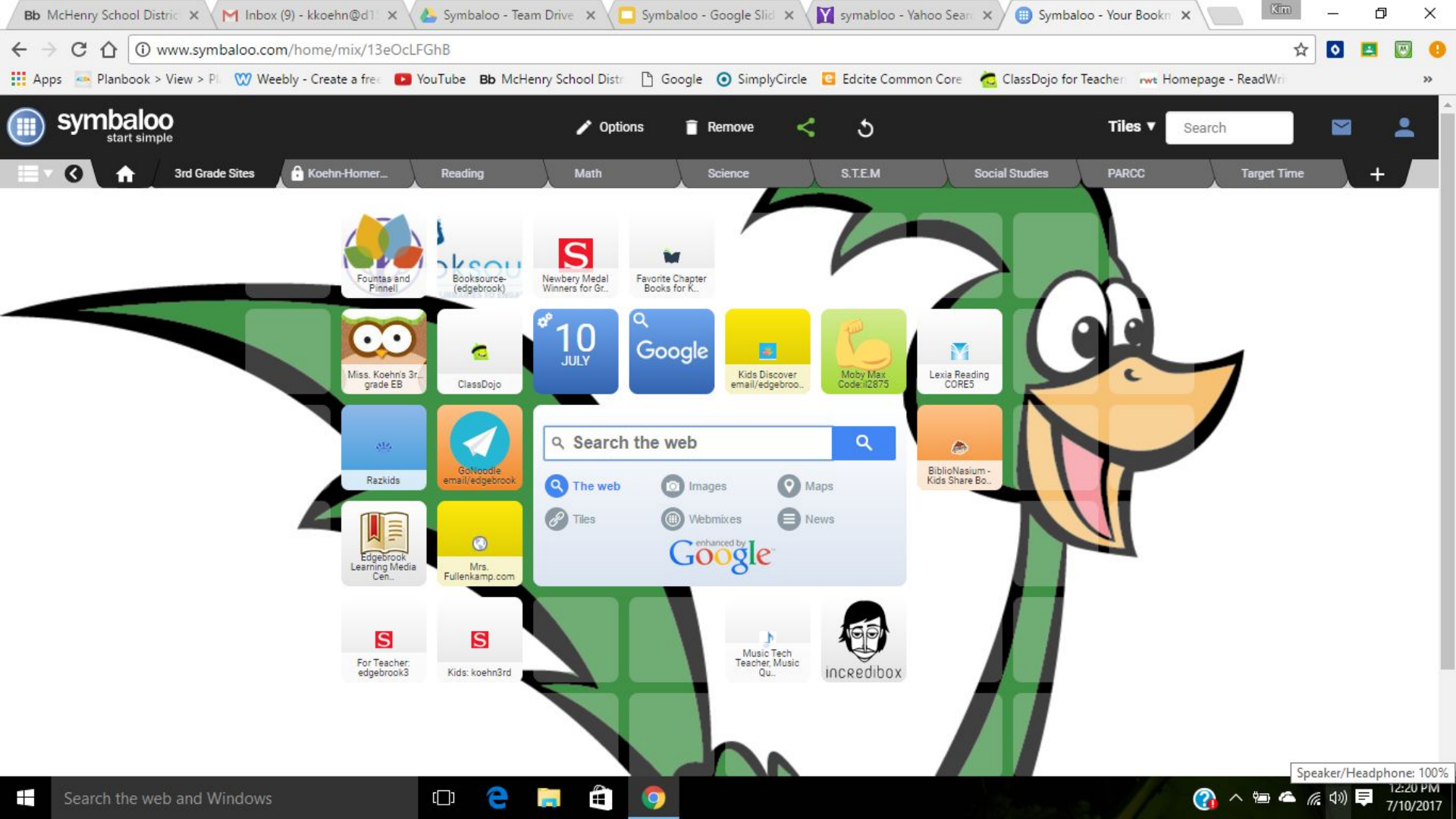
Tile: A link to a website. A Visual representation of a website.

Create + Edit Tiles:

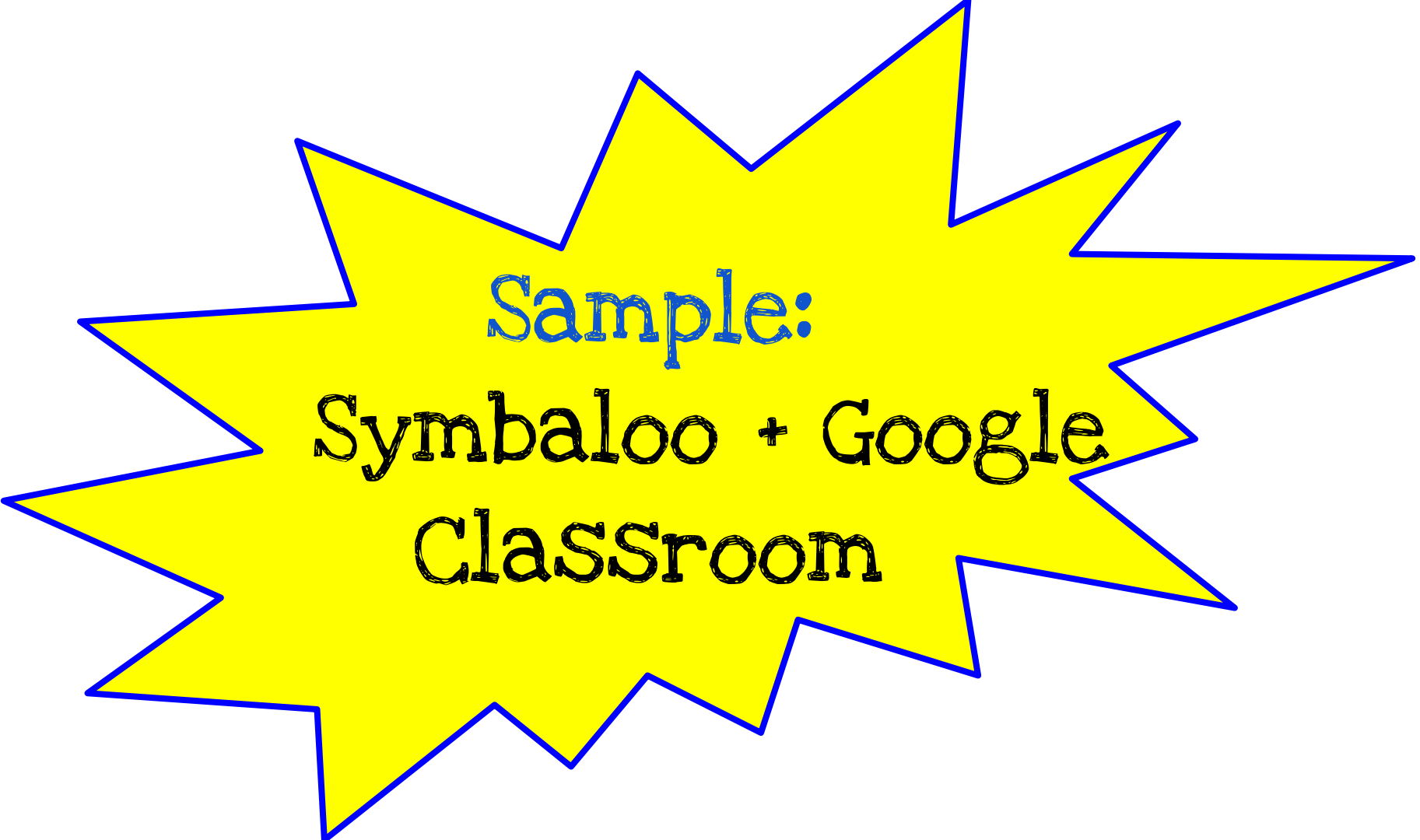
