

Dear Parents and Guardians:

The State of Illinois passed a law in 2013 called, "Erin's Law" mandating that all public schools educate children about sexual abuse prevention through age appropriate curriculum including role plays, discussions, activities, and videos. The purpose of these activities is to give children the tools needed to speak up and tell an adult if anyone has ever touched them inappropriately.

McHenry Middle School is partnering with the CARE Center to present Sexual Abuse Programs in our middle school health classes. One day during this Health term, representatives from the CARE Center will be in your child's classroom, and will discuss a variety of the following concepts:

- Empowerment
- Consent- What is it?
- Saying 'No' activity [what areas of our life influence relationships/gender norms]
- Child Sexual Abuse [Physical/Non Physical]
- Who are abusers/perpetrators

Nationwide, 1 in 3 girls and 1 in 6 boys will be the victim of some type of sexual abuse by the time they reach age 18. Through this program aimed at educating and empowering students, we want to provide your child with the knowledge and skills to use if ever affected by sexual violence.

McHenry Middle School believes that all our students will benefit from participating in this program. However, you may exclude your child by completing the bottom portion of this form and returning it to Mrs. Andresen prior to the presentation.
